WHEREAS: the Northwest Arctic Borough Planning Department received a request from the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC), Division of Environmental Health and Engineering (DEHE) on behalf of the City of Shungnak an easement needed for a heat recovery project in Shungnak as identified on Exhibit A to this Resolution; and

WHEREAS: the project will support a heat recovery project that will save energy and reduce diesel consumption; and

WHEREAS: the easement will serve a public purpose beneficial to the Borough and residents of Shungnak; and

WHEREAS: through Planning Commission Resolution 24-02, the Planning Commission reviewed the easement request and recommended Assembly approval.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly hereby approves conveyance of an easement to the City of Shungnak across Borough property in Shungnak identified as identified on Exhibit A; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: the easement agreement shall include a condition requiring that the easement will terminate, and the property interest will revert back to the Borough in the event the Assembly, by resolution, finds that the real property is not being used for the public purpose stated in this resolution authorizing the conveyance as required by NABC 2.48.090.

DEED OF EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT

Easement SHG-23-P1, Shungnak, Alaska

DEED OF EASEMENT MADE AND ENTERD INTO this ______ day of ______ 2023 by Northwest Arctic Borough, P.O. Box 1110, Kotzebue, Alaska, 99752, hereinafter referred to as the Grantor, and City of Shungnak, P.O. Box 59, Shungnak, Alaska, 99773, hereinafter referred to as the Grantee: That in consideration of \$1.00, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Grantor does hereby grant and convey unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, a public utility easement, for the purpose of a heat recovery expansion project, located on the Grantor's property located within remainder US Survey 2047 of the School Reserve, approved November 9, 1938, Kotzebue Recording District, State of Alaska. The Easement is shown in Exhibit SHG-23-E1 and labeled "Easement SHG-23-P1", and is more specifically that portion of said remainder US Survey 2047, described as follows:

Beginning for reference, at the northwest corner of Lot 8, Block 8, TR C, US Survey 4417, approved May 26, 1967, and a point on the southerly boundary of said remainder US Survey 2047, and the northerly Right of Way of Hall Street; thence N65°57'45"W, 47.93 feet, along the northerly boundary of said Right of Way, to the True Point of Beginning; thence N65°57'45"W, 200.00 feet, along the northerly boundary of said Right of Way to the southwest corner of remainder of US Survey 2047; thence N23°59'00"E, 12.01 feet, along the easterly Right of Way of Back Street; thence S73°51'04"E, 6.47 feet, along the southerly boundary of Public Utility Easement, Document #2010-000273-0; thence N72°54'38"E, 178.97 feet, along said Public Utility Easement; thence S19°17'09"W, 131.07 feet, along said Public Utility Easement to the True Point Of Beginning.

Said parcel contains 10,463 sq. feet, more or less.

QUALIFICATIONS:

THE EASEMENT IS GRANTED subject to the following terms and conditions: The Grantor hereby disclaims any warranty that it has any title, including marketable title, to the Easement.

The Grantee hereby covenants with the Grantor, that it will construct and maintain the aforesaid improvements on the Easement in a workmanlike manner. All work on and use of the Easement shall be performed in accordance with any applicable codes, regulations or laws. The costs of constructing, maintaining and managing the heat recovery project and any and all other costs related to Grantee's use of the Easement shall be borne solely by Grantee.

In addition, the Grantee shall indemnify the Grantor against liability for damages to life or property arising from Grantee's occupancy or use of the Easement, and Grantee restore the Easement as nearly as may be possible to its original condition upon completion of construction in accordance with acceptable engineering principles.

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The Grantor reserves the right to use the Easement in any way and for any purpose so long as such use does not unreasonably interfere with the rights hereby granted to the Grantee.

The Easement is perpetual so long as it shall actually be used for the purpose stated herein; provided, however, that in accordance with the Northwest Arctic Borough Code Section 2.48.090(E), as may be amended from time to time, title to the Easement shall automatically be re-vested in the Grantor in the event that the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly finds by resolution that the Easement is not being used for the public purpose stated in the resolution authorizing the conveyance of this Easement and records such resolution in the above recording district.
