**A RESOLUTION OF THE NORTHWEST ARCTIC  
BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TO DISCONTINUE THE  
BOROUGH'S PROVISION OF HEALTH INSURANCE  
BENEFITS FOR ASSEMBLY MEMBERS.**

**WHEREAS:** the Borough is the home rule regional government for Northwest Alaska; and

**WHEREAS:** the Borough has historically provided health insurance benefits for its Assembly members; and

**WHEREAS:** health insurance costs have soared, and for FY25, the cost to insure the Assembly's eleven members will exceed \$333,000; and


**WHEREAS:** as a municipal government, the Borough is only one of two municipal governments for which the Borough is aware that provides the members of its governing body with health insurance benefits; and

**WHEREAS:** currently, all Assembly members have alternative sources of health insurance; and

**WHEREAS:** in the face of declining revenue and in a concerted effort to better utilize funds for public services and programs, the Assembly wishes to discontinue providing its members with health insurance benefits.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** that the Northwest Arctic Borough Assembly hereby discontinues the Borough's provision of health insurance for Assembly members.
